

We have installed over 500 cloakrooms in theatres, clubs, exhibition centres, museums, bars and restaurants in various countries. In this cloakroom factsheet you will find our knowledge top 10: this how your cloakroom turns into an efficient, profitable business.

- Always hang a set of legally approved cloakroom rules in a visible place. This limits your liability in case of lost items.
- Charge a reasonable price for each item that is collected. An avarage price is €1 to €1,50. Even without a charge you are liable for losses.
- Customers should pay per item handed in and receive a separate ticket for each. As you are liable for each item, charging individually is reasonable.
- Separate the most expensive coats like leather coats on a separate garment rail rack. Most losses tend to be of expensive coats...
- Check your turnover regularly, either by counting all items or by using a cash register / electronic ticketing system.

- Use your space: most cloakrooms are too small.
 Use double rail racks to increase capacity.
 Almost 90% of coats handed in are short coats.
- Higher speed = better service = higher turnover.
 Use racks on wheels, this will save up to 100 walks per garment rack.
- Divide your cloakroom into sections (A, B, C, etc.)
 Sections will create a quicker and well organized cloakroom. This will increase your turnover.
- If you are experiencing extreme visitor numbers, you might consider handing out empty coat hangers in a queue. Incredibly fast!
